Studying at Dunboyne College

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- Applications can be made online at www. dunboynecollege.ie. from November 2022 to September 2023.
- 2. After registering online, students will receive a text and email to notify them they have pre-registered and can log in to view and track their application.
- **3.** Applicants will be notified by text and email of a request to upload further information for their application:
- (i). Copy of most recent school report or examination results
- (ii). Reference from teacher, employer or coach
- (iv). 100-word personal statement on, "Why this course is right for me," which should outline reasons for choosing the course.
- (v) Photograph
- **(vi)** Interviews may also take place for some courses.
- **4.** Successful applicants will then be able to pay fees online at www.dunboynecollege.ie.
- **5.** Late applicants can apply online for vacant places at any time before September 2023.
- **6.** A grant can be applied for from www.susi.ie.

A separate process for applicants to the Early Learning and Care courses (formerly Childcare courses) applies.

Applicants for the Accounting Technician Apprenticeship do not apply via the online system, please contact the college re the application process.

FEES

Course fees are paid before registration and include course materials, examination fees and €30 non-refundable deposit.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Payment of the full fee within the specified timeframe guarantees a student a place on the course they have been offered.

No cash will be accepted at the office. Payments can only be made online.

All students can claim a refund for their courses up to Friday, 29th September 2023 if they decline their place. Fees are non-refundable after this date.

Demand for places is usually high. We may interview for all courses. All prospective students should apply early.

Please note that all courses in Dunboyne College are officially full-time courses, although you may only receive direct tuition in the college for 2-4 days per week. It is expected that students will use the other days for work experience or for study and assignments. Any letter confirming a student's registration in the college will state that the course is full-time.

Timetables are issued in September on day of start-up.

Studying at Dunboyne College

ASSESSMENT

Most courses will be assessed through continuous assessment. This means that modules are assessed with a combination of exams and assignments. Assignments can take various forms, including written projects, reports, essays, skills demonstrations, oral presentations or electronic work. Results for exams and assignments are combined to give the overall result for the module.

GRADING SCHEME FOR ASSESSMENT

The following grading scheme, used by Dunboyne College of Further Education in relation to QQI Level 5 and Level 6 Courses, is as follows:

80 - 100% Distinction 65 - 79% Merit 50 - 64% Pass

0 - 49% Unsuccessful

Briefs (explanatory documents) will be given to students by the teachers for all assessments.

There are six possible assessment techniques:

- 1. Collection of Work
- 2. Student Record
- 3. Examination
- 4. Assignment
- **5.** Project
- 6. Skills Demonstration

HIGHER EDUCATION LINKS SCHEME:

Students who graduate with a full QQI award from Dunboyne College can apply through the CAO using these results for a quota of reserved places at universities.

This gives students an extra set of results, a separate pathway other than Leaving Certificate for progression to Higher Education degrees.

Higher Education Links Scheme

The Higher Education Links Scheme facilitates students from Dunboyne College who have achieved a full QQI Level 5 Certificate or Level 6 Advanced Certificate to progress to a range of courses at higher education institutions throughout the country.

There are currently over forty higher education institutions offering progression to a wide variety of Level 6 Higher Certificate, Level 7 Ordinary

Degree and Level 8 Honours Degree programmes, all of which form part of the National Framework of Qualifications.

To apply, current students submit their third level applications to the CAO by 1st February. In July QQI results are issued to the CAO and the participating institutions. The best eight modules are scored (based on Distinction/Merit/ Pass results) and applicants are ranked accordingly.

Student Facilities

COLLEGE ADMINISTRATION OFFICE

The college administration office is open between 8:00am and 4:00pm Monday to Friday. Students' queries are dealt with during these hours. Documents which require the college stamp may be left in the office and will usually be ready for collection the following day.

LIBRARY

The college library is open every day from 8.00am to 4.00pm. The library is equipped with both module specific books and a collection of eBooks for further study. Students need their college ID to borrow books, and can take out books for up to two weeks at a time. The library provides computers and desk space for independent study as well as a colour printer for student use.

COFFEE SHOP

Open from 8:30am to 4:00pm Monday to Friday. The coffee shop operates as a private franchise and supplies soup, tea, coffee, hot chocolate, snacks, and fresh sandwiches. Students are requested to cooperate in keeping the coffee shop tidy.

WORK EXPERIENCE

This is a core module, which means that a student will not be awarded their full QQI certificate unless they pass the Work Experience module. The module requires the completion of assignments and a mandatory work placement with an employer for the duration of the academic year. You must pass both the assignments and the placement in order to pass the module.

The placement must be in an area that relates to your course and/or the modules that you are studying. It is part of your course and learning that you arrange your

own work placement. We recommend that you start this process as soon as possible after commencing your course. Work Experience teachers will offer advice regarding suitable organisations to ensure students experience relevant and valuable work placements. Before confirming a placement you should consult with your work experience teacher.

Placements generally take place on the days that you do not have timetabled classes. Some courses also require block placements. You will be advised by your Work Experience teacher of the format and arrangements of your placement. Employers will advertise work placements via Moodle announcements and some may visit the college to promote placement opportunities.

Students who wish to work with children and minors in any capacity or vulnerable adults need to be garda vetted before undertaking work experience. This applies to those enrolled on healthcare courses e.g. Nursing, Healthcare Assistant, Pre-Paramedic, Childcare, Youthwork, Applied Social Studies. This can also apply to students on a sports course or a pre-arts course. Details on the Garda Vetting process will be provided at the start of the course.

Students on Nursing Studies and Health Care Assistant must complete specific requirements which will be issued to them by their Work Experience tutors, before commencing a clinical placement.

Specific requirements for placement also apply to those studying on the Early Learning and Care course (formerly Childcare). Full details will be provided on the commencement of your course.

College Communication with Students

WEB-TEXTING

Web-texting is a quick and simple service of sending text messages to mobile phones from any web-enabled computer in minutes. The college may use this service to inform individual students or class groups about various issues that may arise.

MOODLE

Moodle is a course management system that provides an effective learning platform for students to enhance communication. The system provides access to a wide variety of resources. The college also uses this platform to issue important notices to students. Students are issued with login details at the start of their course. Teachers upload notes and details of assessment instructions.

E-MAIL

Students attending Dunboyne College of Further Education will be provided with a college email address. The college will only use this email address to communicate with the student. It is important that students log in to their college email daily.

Dunboyne College welcomes applications from students with special needs and makes provision, wherever possible, to facilitate access and participation in the academic courses and student life.

Support Services

MATURE STUDENTS SUPPORT

The college welcomes adults over 23 who wish to return to education and who wish to retrain in new skills and technologies. A meeting is arranged early in the academic year, this gives the student an opportunity to meet other mature students and to become familiar with the college.

We also organise lunchtime meetings and refreshments for mature students on a regular basis.

A special study skills seminar is run for mature students in the first few weeks of college. Additional supports are readily available, particularly around the areas of IT and competent use of computers. Mature students are encouraged to attend these once-off meetings, as they will help students to adjust to college life. Students are encouraged to visit the student support office regularly.

CAREER GUIDANCE

The Career Guidance and Counselling department team are Meabh Nimmo and Derek Ball. Meabh and Derek will visit each class regularly during the academic year to provide information and advice on the following:

- Timetables and Awards
- CAO, UCAS (UK) and Direct Applications
- Employment Options
- The Higher Education Links Scheme
- HEAR and DARE
- Mature Applications
- Career Research

Our Guidance Department team will be available throughout the year. Students may make an appointment through the Dunboyne College website or MyDCFE, or avail of the drop-in service. They can obtain advice and practical guidance on planning their career progression to further study or employment.

Central Applications Office (CAO) applications for third level courses close in January (for reduced fee applications) and 1st February for normal applications.

COUNSELLING

Personal Counselling is available to students to assist with issues which may arise in the course of the academic year, for example, difficulty in adjusting to college demands, time management, exam anxiety, or other ongoing concerns. Personal counselling is bound by strict confidential ethical guidelines. Grant Information

BACK TO EDUCATION ALLOWANCE

The Back to Education Allowance (BTEA) allows qualifying persons to return to full-time education in approved courses while continuing to get income support.

The BTEA allows people in receipt of certain social welfare payments to retain those payments whilst participating in approved full-time courses in further and higher education.

Check www.studentfinance.ie for more information or talk to your local Social Welfare Office.

MAINTENANCE GRANTS

Students who are entering an approved full-time Post Leaving Certificate (PLC) course for the first time in 2023/2024 or who are already attending approved PLC courses are eligible to apply for a maintenance grant. This grant does not cover the cost of registration or examination fees. It is a maintenance grant paid each month directly into the student's bank account.

Students apply for the PLC Maintenance Grant at www. susi.ie. It is not necessary for students to know the exact course they will be attending in September in order to apply for a PLC Maintenance Grant. The initial decision regarding the grant is based solely on income. The PLC Maintenance Grant is a means tested grant. This involves an assessment of the earnings in the family (parents and candidate). Students over 23 years of age in the year of entry to the course who are living outside the family home will be assessed on their income and that of their spouse (if applicable). 

ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY

Students who do not have English as a first language may be asked to take a proficiency test to ascertain whether they will benefit from a specific course. It may be advisable for some students to consider a QQI Level 4 programme while improving their language skills. We do have English as an Additional Language (EAL) support in place for students whose English is at an appropriate standard in order for them to participate in a Level 5 course, but who may need help with language skills.

COLLEGE START PROGRAMME

Feeling nervous about pursuing your education? Why not avail of our college start programme which allows you to complete your QQI Level 5 over the space of two years. With additional support and supplemental options, this programme could be what you need to get you started on the pathway to your future career.

WHAT IS APPLIED SOCIAL STUDIES?

This one-year course will aim to prepare students for work with people in a social care, community development or residential setting. The care worker needs social, communication and caring skills to work with individuals and groups. Many of the skills acquired will be transferable for use with adolescents, families and the elderly in a caring, educational or development role. The Applied Social Studies QQI course will lay a foundation for these skills and provide the work experience to put learning into practice. This course will serve as training for social care/community care/healthcare sectors or as a link to Applied Social Studies/ Social Care or Nursing certificate or degree courses in many Technological Universities throughout the country. This programme is ideal for both school leavers and experienced mature persons seeking a qualification in this area

COURSE CONTENT

A theoretical approach to community and health services/social studies will be complemented by practical experience. The following modules will be offered subject to availability and demand:

CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

Graduates may pursue a certificate or degree course in many of the Universities around the country or alternatively may seek immediate employment in a range of Community Care, Health Care, and Community Development centres/initiatives. There are now a large range of Social Studies or Community Care certificate and degree courses available to graduates on the newly expanded QQI links programme. 

Accounting Technician Apprenticeship



Accounting Technician Apprenticeship?

WHAT IS ACCOUNTING TECHNICIAN APPRENTICESHIP?

The Accounting Technician Apprenticeship is a two-year, work-based learning programme which leads to a Level 6 Advanced Certificate in Accounting. It is a pathway to a career in Accounting. Unlike college courses, an apprenticeship is an opportunity to earn money and become qualified while you are learning on-the-job.

As an apprentice you will spend one day a week in Dunboyne College of Further Education during the academic year (off-the-job training) and work with an employer for the remaining four days (on-the-job training). Outside of term time you will be working with the employer five days a week (Monday - Friday). The rate of pay is agreed between you and your employer. The employer pays you a salary while you are being trained on-the-job and off-the-job. Accounting Technician apprentices earn a minimum of €21,060 per annum during their apprenticeship.

Throughout the two years an apprentice will be supported by a college mentor and a workplace mentor assigned by their employer to oversee and support them during the on the job training period. Additional study in the evenings or at the weekend will be needed to ensure success in this apprenticeship. This apprenticeship equips you with employable business skills, and a strong technical knowledge of finance and accountancy practice. Everything you learn will support and inform your work with your employer, providing you with the opportunity to apply newly gained knowledge and skills on a daily basis.

Places are awarded via a competitive interview process, where applicants who meet the entry requirements are put forward to participating employers for consideration.

If you are successful at interview stage and accepted by an employer, your new employer will issue you with a two-year contract and you start your apprenticeship in September 2023.

- A minimum of 300 CAO points (or equivalent) within the last 5 years with a pass grade in English, and Maths or Accounting.
- If you sat the Leaving Certificate more than 5 years ago, you should have a minimum of 300 CAO points (or equivalent) with a D3 in Ordinary level English, and Maths or Accounting.
- If you do not have a pass in Leaving Certificate English or equivalent, then you must be able to supply evidence of competency in written and spoken English.
- Students who hold other qualifications at level 5 should contact the college to discuss their application.
- Individual employers reserve the right to require additional entry requirements.

QQILEVEL 6 COURSES

Dunboyne College of Further Education offers a series of Level 6 qualifications in some of its departments where there is great demand for a second-year programme to upgrade skills and abilities. Those who have completed a QQI Level 5 or an equivalent qualification in a related area will be eligible to progress to these second-year programmes. Level 6 programmes are offered subject to demand. A brief description and a general indication of the modules offered is contained below. The modules will be determined by the number of students taking up the individual programmes along with market trends.

ADVANCED CERTIFICATION IN EARLY CHILDHOOD CARE AND EDUCATION (6M2007)*

This Level 6 course is an advanced course designed to suit students with previous childcare training at Level 5 who wish to develop a career in childcare at the supervisory management level. The modules on the programme will include Child Development, Early Childhood Curriculum, Child-hood Social, Legal and Health Studies, Work Experience, Communications, Supervision in Childcare, and Special Needs Assisting. These childcare modules will be supplemented with courses from the Business, Social Care and Nursing areas which will equip students for a wider range of career opportunities in childcare management. On the successful completion of the award the student will have acquired the knowledge, skills and competence to work in an early childhood education and care setting. Skills acquired will provide the successful student with the ability to lead and co-ordinate a team in the provision of an early childhood care and education. This award will provide students with opportunities to transfer and progress to programmes leading to higher education and training awards at Level 7 and Level 8.

* This is the final year that this course will be offered in this format due to upcoming changes to the course from QQI.

ADVANCED CERTIFICATE IN PROFESSIONAL COOKERY

(6M2099)

This course is designed to equip the student with the relevant knowledge, skills and competence to work using a range of specialised skills in a professional kitchen. The course provides the student with an opportunity to obtain experience in a wide range of specialised areas such as food and beverage services, bakeries, and busy restaurants while gaining a sound general knowledge in areas needed to function in the hotel and catering environment. 
EQUINE BREEDING (6M3507)


